



## Mountain Region Competition IMPORTANT ARCHERY NOTICE

The following guidelines have been adopted for the Mountain Region Archery Competition. *Please read these carefully and be prepared to help us with their implementation!*

### Additional Archery Guidelines

- Competitors must bring at least six arrows (field points only, NO BROADHEADS).
- Contestants are encouraged to bring their own bows in order to help make the most efficient use of time.
- All contestants, coaches, and officials must stay behind the shooting line. *Only when the line is called safe may a contestant, coach, or official go beyond the shooting line.*
- *Contestants must lay down their bows while arrows are being retrieved.*
- *Each school is strongly encouraged to provide at least one adult to help as a tournament official.*

Following are additional archery guidelines.

### Archery (Fall Activity)

The competition will be field archery (circle targets), and archers will shoot 4 flights of 5 arrows (20 total). The number of competitors will not be limited, but schools must register when requested to allow for a sufficient number of targets to be set up. Ribbons will be awarded to the first-place, second-place, and third-place boy and girl in each age division. First-place, second-place, and third-place team trophies will also be awarded. These trophies will be determined by adding the two top scores for each school in each division.

Levels and target distance:	8 years and under	10 yards
