

Mountain Region Competition IMPORTANT ARCHERY NOTICE

The following guidelines have been adopted for the Mountain Region Archery Competition. Please read these carefully and be prepared to help us with their implementation!

Additional Archery Guidelines

- Competitors must bring at least six arrows (field points only, NO BROADHEADS).
- Contestants are encouraged to bring their own bows in order to help make the most efficient use of time.
- <u>All contestants, coaches, and officials must stay behind the shooting line.</u>
 Only when the line is called safe may a contestant, coach, or official go beyond the shooting line.
- Contestants must lay down their bows while arrows are being retrieved.
- Each school is strongly encouraged to provide at least one adult to help as a tournament official.

Following are additional archery guidelines.

Archery (Fall Activity)

The competition will be field archery (circle targets), and archers will shoot 4 flights of 5 arrows (20 total). The number of competitors will not be limited, but schools must register when requested to allow for a sufficient number of targets to be set up. Ribbons will be awarded to the first-place, second-place, and third-place boy and girl in each age division. First-place, second-place, and third-place team trophies will also be awarded. These trophies will be determined by adding the two top scores for each school in each division.

Levels and target distance:	8 years and under	10 yards
